Conditions

- The owner shall comply with all applicable laws of the State of Ohio and ordinances, policies and specifications of the Village of Kingston pertaining to construction, repair, replacement, maintenance, tapping or removal of a sanitary sewer main or lateral connected directly or indirectly to the Village of Kingston sewerage system.
- No clean water connection may be made to the sanitary sewer system.
- All areas disturbed shall be restored to its original or better condition in accordance with Village of Kingston standard.
- The owner shall be responsible to maintain service from the tap, be it in the street or behind the curb.
- The Village of Kingston does not guarantee the accuracy of the location of any existing taps installed during sanitary sewer installation, It shall be the owners responsibility to furnish an acceptable sewer tap from the village sewer to the structure. The village shall not be held liable for any costs incurred in furnishing this tap..
- This tap shall be subject to any future change of policy or rule or regulation addition or change in the future.
- A sewer tap fee must be paid before a tap shall be installed. This permit covers the tap fee for 12 months. After expiration, permit holder is subject to the new fee structure.
- The sewer tapper is responsible for notifying all utilities and the Ohio Utilities Protection Services a minimum of forty eight (48) hours before beginning work.
- Work must be completed by a licensed and bonded contractor.
